## **June 2010 - Yorkshire Team latest Update**

### **Regatta dates**

The regatta may fall in the last week of term but attendance at the event qualifies as a valid 'out of classroom' activity and competitors will not be marked absent from school

### **Yorkshire Team Managers**

Unfortunately, Robin Wright will not be joining us this year as Ollie is not too well but Jim Hackney has offered his services again and William Redman, our new chairman, will also be accompanying the team. However, we still need a female member of staff as well so if any of our adult supporters (male or female) can help out please let Jim or William know ASAP. We will have to limit the number of competitors if not enough staff are available. If so, the team will be chosen on a 'first come, first served' basis.

### **Sailing Programme**

There will be the usual full sailing programme involving 10 points races from Monday to Friday on three separate race tracks for: Topper, Laser Full and Radial, Handicap and Rookie fleets. On Wednesday points racing gives way to three separate events: the Single Handers' Race in Toppers, the All Comers Race (a Handicap event) and the premier event of the regatta, the Mount Haes, a restricted entry, knockout competition in Xenon dinghies kindly supplied by Topper International Ltd.

### **Regatta Venue**

This year it's **Datchet Water SC, Queen Mother Reservoir, Slough, SL3 9NT** As last year at Brid., Camping, food and sailing will all be accommodated at the reservoir site. Please arrange to arrive with boats on Sunday afternoon. Departure will normally be after breakfast on Saturday morning. **Please make sure you attend the on-site briefing for all competitors and staff on Sunday evening.**

### **Camping/Food**

Six nights camping and food will be available on site. The Caterers will provide breakfast, packed lunch and dinner starting on Sunday evening through to Saturday breakfast.

### **Evening Social Programme**

Commodore's Reception at 8.30pm on Monday for Team Managers and Captains. It is hoped that NSSA president, Jim Saltonstall will be joining us during the week. The Social Programme will include sports tournaments, cinema visits, coaching sessions, dragon boat racing and the usual Friday evening Prizegiving followed by a disco/social.
